



BROWN HILL CREEK STAGE 2

The Brownhill Creek redevelopment project involved the clean up of this section of the creek and the reconstruction of the channel to create a low flow channel in addition to an increase in the overall flow capacity of the creek. The installation of footbridges, pedestrian paths and landscaping will also improve the accessibility and amenity of the environment

Key features include:

- Installation of two footbridges and pedestrian paths
- Construction of gabion weirs and scour protection
- Construction in wet, saturated conditions
- Construction in environmentally sensitive area
- Installation of high value landscape scheme
- Management of local stakeholder issues
- Two (2) year Maintenance of Landscaping/Planting Works
